Segment	Activity
Story	The Very Busy Spider – Eric Carle
Phonological Awareness	Beginning Sounds – Hungry for \h\ <u>Print lunch</u> <u>box and pictures</u> Help students bounce beginning sounds Only add things to the lunchbox that start w \h\ (some are not foods, this makes it silly!)
Music & Movement	Listen & Move
Literacy	Spider web counting- Draw a web and Print out lots of spider pictures. Write numbers 1-10 on paper, have child select a number, and glue that number of spiders on the web.
Journals	Draw a black Widow Spider. What Makes them unique?
Learning Activity 2	Spider Web Toss- create a web using a hula hoop and duct tape. Have child toss paper (flies) to the sticky side of the web. Ask math/science/literacy questions to earn extra "flies"
Small Group Activity	Uppercase and lowercase dance- Write 5 letters upper and lowercase on separate sheets of paper. Line uppercase one side, lowercase facing the other side. Adult leads by stepping on one letter, child follows by stepping on the corresponding letter. You can switch turns leading.
