Segment	Activity
Story	You can't taste a pickle with your ear! - Harriet Ziefert
Phonological Awareness	Rhyming Bingo – Create a 6 square Bingo chart with pictures. Students Will place a bingo chip when they Match a picture to the rhyming word that they hear.
Music & Movement	A Ram Sam Sam Dance
Literacy	Make a cube, with 5 senses body Parts (Eyes, Hands, Nose, Mouth, Ears). Students will roll the cube and name what sense they use with that Part
Journals	Draw three things that taste sweet
Learning Activity 2	TASTE TEST- students will describe the taste of 4-5 foods. Give examples of descriptors for taste. Blind fold the students and let them guess what they might be tasting! Extend further by classifying foods by taste (sweet, sour, bitter, etc.)
Small Group Activity	Beginning Sounds – Hungry for \b\  Print lunch box and pictures  Help students bounce beginning sounds  Only add things to the lunchbox that start w  \b\ (some are not foods, this makes it silly!)
